### **Roof Repair Update**

We wanted to let the congregation know of repairs to the church roof that are needed immediately. We have over the last 2 winters experienced ice dams over the front door and in the back over the offices. Both have caused damage to the roof. The roof is now leaking with several rafters sagging which is causing the problem. The concern is that this winter could be harsh and more severe damage could occur. We have called out 3 companies to look at the situation and the board agreed to hire Reliance Roof Troop to do the work. The work has already been completed. The cost will be \$8922.00. We have filed a claim with our insurance company. An adjuster came out to inspect the damage and there was some damage done due to weather. 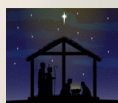

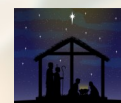
