New Sermon Series Launch: Letters of Fire
Exploring Paul's Epistles Through the Spirit's Flame
From Pentecost to Advent | Sundays at FCC (DOC) Highland, IN

Throughout this Pentecost season, we're igniting something powerful. Beginning Pentecost Sunday, June 8th, we launch a new 25-week sermon series titled "Letters of Fire: Paul's Epistles Through the Lens of Pentecost." This series invites us to walk alongside the Apostle Paul, not just as a distant theologian, but as a Spirit-filled guide—someone whose life and letters still burn with urgency, compassion, and transformational truth.

Why "Letters of Fire"?

At Pentecost, the Holy Spirit came like tongues of flame, empowering the early church with boldness, unity, and love. As we journey through Paul's epistles this season, we'll see how that same Spirit continues to shape our lives today—rekindling faith, challenging assumptions, stirring hope, and calling us to deeper community and courageous witness.

Each week, we'll explore a different letter or passage from Paul, paired with prayerful reflection, discussion questions for small groups, and hands-on activities that bring the message to life. From Romans to Philippians, from prison letters to pastoral ones, we'll discover that

Paul's words weren't written in cold ink—they were set ablaze by the Holy Spirit.

Whether you're new to Paul's writings or have read them for years, this series is for *you*. Come with questions, doubts, passion, and openness. Come expecting fire.

Join us every Sunday at 10:30 A.M., and invite a friend, neighbor, or coworker. Let's journey together from Pentecost to Advent, hearts open to the Spirit, as we read these ancient letters with fresh eyes and renewed faith.
